

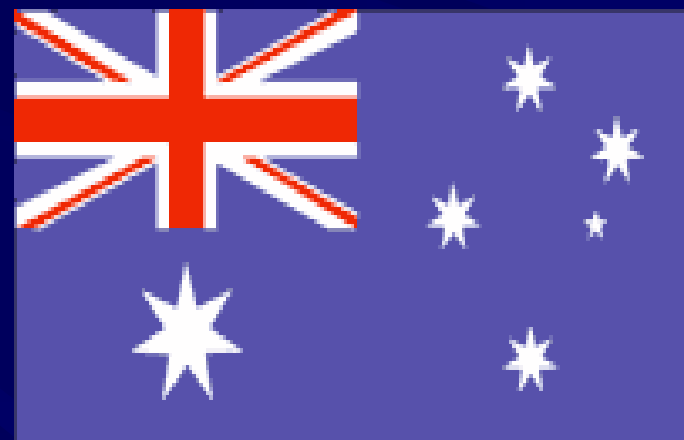

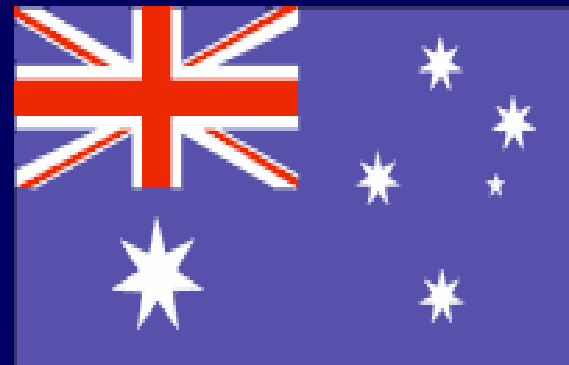


Facts and statistics

- **Location:** Oceania, continent between the Indian Ocean and the South Pacific Ocean
- **Area:** 7,686,848 sq km
- **Capital:** Canberra
- **Population:** 19,913,144 (July 2004 est.)
- **Climate:** generally arid to semiarid; temperate in south and east; tropical in north
- **Ethnic Make-up:** Caucasian 92%, Asian 7%, aboriginal and other 1%
- **Religions:** Anglican 26.1%, Roman Catholic 26%, other Christian 24.3%, non-Christian 11%, other 12.6%
- **Government:** democratic, federal-state system recognizing the British monarch as sovereign.
- **Currency:** Australian dollar = 100 cents
- **Languages:** English is the primary language used in Australia; Aboriginal languages

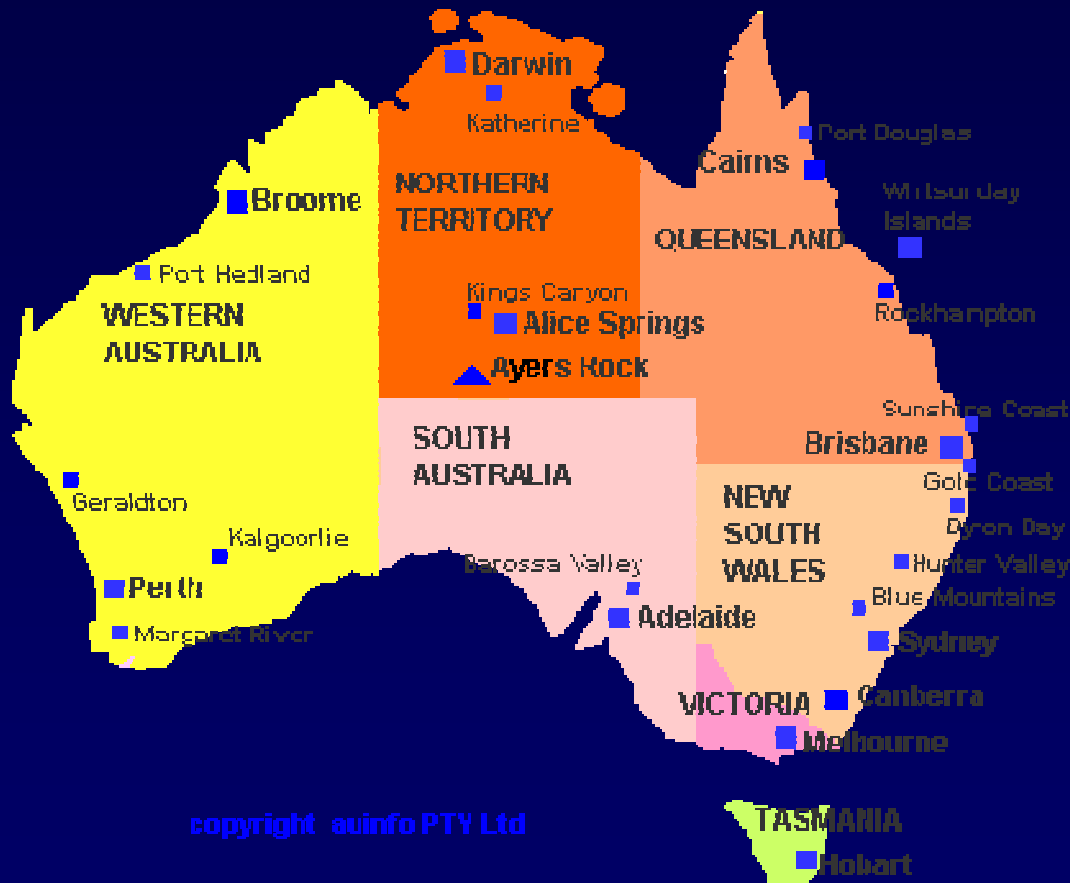
Flag

- The flag of Australia is the only one to fly over a whole continent. The small Union Jack represents the historical link with Britain, the large seven-pointed star represents the six States and Territories, and the small stars from the Southern Cross – a prominent feature of the southern hemisphere night sky.
