The Scottish flag, known as the Saltire, is a blue field with a white saltire (X-shaped cross) in the center.

Until 1603, Scotland and England were separate countries with their own monarchs and parliaments. Cousin of Elizabeth I, James VI - the King of Scotland -, became King James I of England, too. In 1999, Scotland got its own parliament again.

Scotland has got its own traditions, history and even language, Scots Gaelic.

There are three parts to the country :

- The Highlands and Islands in the north
- The Lowlands in the centre
- The Uplands in the south

Scottish folk music and traditional dancing are very popular. In summer a lot of people go to the **Highland Games** and watch dancing, sports and bagpipe competitions. Bagpipes have got 4 pipes. Three of them play a steady note and the last one plays the tune.



The Scottish national costume for men is kind of skirt called a **kilt**. Many areas of Scotland were very wet and was it was difficult to run and walk in wet trousers. It was much easier to move in a wet kilt. The cloth is made of wool and it is called tartan. There are a lot patterns and colours, some of them are part of the history of a family clan. **The Scottish kilt is made from 8 metres of tartan cloth.**



The traditional Scottish food is Scotch broth - vegetable and barley soup, and cock - a - leekie, chicken and leek soup with prunes.

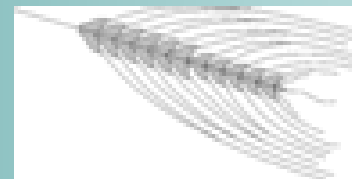
