1. HOW TO REPORT AN EMERGENCY? (First: brainstorming; then: tell the students what to do)

➤ Before you dial the number:

- Try to calm down
- Try to orientate yourself (place, name of town and street, number of highway and kilometre, etc.)

➤ When you call, please tell the operator:

WHAT (has) happened?

WHERE did it happen?

WHEN did it happen?

WHO is calling? What is your name and call number?

2. EMERGENCY CALLS

Pair work – one student has one piece of information about the emergency, the second one is the operator receiving the information and his task is to gain all the necessary information and write them down:

Card 1 You witness the fire on the second floor in the block of flats. There is a man screaming at the window.	Card 2 You are on the Main Street and you see the car accident of two cars and one truck. There is some liquid on the road. And there are some people in the cars, but you are not able to say whether they are injured or death.
Card 3 It is night and you are on the highway. In front of you, there are three fallen trees. No other car is there.	Card 4 There was a thunderstorm and after the storm, there is probably a lightning fire in the neighbour's house. You live in Prague, in Old Town.
Card 5 There was a heavy rain and there is some water in your cellar. You need to pump the water out of the cellar.	Card 6 You look out of the window and you see the blaze in the neighbour's stable. You know there are some animals in the stable but you don't know which one.

Useful questions (if needed):

What is your full name?

What is the exact address of the emergency (street name, street number)?

What is the phone number you are calling from?

What happened?
